

Be Responsible: Love Your Dog Leash Your Dog

Safety For Your Dog.

Keeping your dog at home or under control of the leash when walking eliminates:

- ✓ Risk of being hit by a car or truck
- ✓ Risk of ingesting poison (bait, antifreeze, chemicals)
- ✓ Risk of contact with rabid animal
- ✓ Risk of attack by another roaming dog
- ✓ Risk of contact with parasite or disease contaminated fecal matter
- ✓ Risk of accidental breeding & unwanted puppies

Safety for the community.

A dog who is well trained and friendly at home can become destructive running at large; or could bite if frightened.

- ✓ Prevents destruction of property
- ✓ Prevents destruction of livestock
- ✓ Lowers incidents of dog bites
- ✓ Lowers spread of disease

Don't allow your dog to roam freely. Whether or not your community has a leash law, be a responsible owner - please keep your dog at home or on a leash. Consider the safety of your dog and respect the property of others in your community.
